Guideline: 4 Onsite Lessons Per Grade Per Year From K - Gr. 12 Using Archdiocesan-Recommended Curricula

Preschool Materials for Catholic Schools (2 – 3 days/week programs for four-year-olds)

(Please note that preschool instruction is part of Archdiocesan recommended practices. However, instruction is not mandated by the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*.)

Suggested Lessons: 2 Lessons, 10 – 15 Minutes Each, Introduction of NCMEC’s Safety Rules

Preschool Session 1: Use Modified Lesson Plan from PCYI office (10 - 15 minutes).

Kindergarten Materials for Catholic Schools

(Please note that instruction is mandated by the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, and “will begin no later than Kindergarten”, as outlined in the USCCB “Safe Environment Training of Children in the Catholic Church” work group report, p. 4, published April of 2007.)

Kindergarten Session 1: Use Modified Lesson Plan from PCYI office (10 - 15 minutes). Use either poster #NC28 (same as described above in Preschool section) or “For Going To and From School More Safely” (NC#91).

Kindergarten Session 2 & 3: Use Power of Parents Teachable Moments Guide: “Shine the Light on Child Safety” and “The Great Tomato Adventure” book (30 minutes). Guideline: 4 Onsite Lessons Per Grade Per Year From K - Gr. 12 Using Archdiocesan-Recommended Curricula

Catholic high schools in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis have been given the option of teaching the curriculum content as units within their term-designed course schedules. Many schools are placing the content in health, moral decision-making and/or technology safety instruction. Some schools are placing all instruction in two terms; others are spreading the information out so students receive instruction every year. The focus of the content is personal safety awareness and instruction. Although chastity education is equally important, only the personal safety awareness and instruction is audited as a result of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*.

School faculties may change the sequence of these lessons. Grade 9 Supplemental Materials: Diocese of Orange: Breaking the Silence

This is best suited as an introduction to Fr. McGlone's "Creating Safe and Sacred Places" at the 9th grade level or if Fr. McGlone's materials are used in 9th and 10th grade, this would be well-suited for youth ministry programs. An archdiocesan lesson plan is included with materials. There are suggestions for teens and also suggestions for parents, if separate gatherings are planned.

High School Curricula Using Fr. McGlone's "Creating Safe and Sacred Places"

Creating Safe and Sacred Places continues to be the primary text.

Activities from sessions 5, 6, 7, and 8 may be used to create units of lessons.

Some sites are using the "Prayer Service of Reconciliation and Rededication" (pages 152 – 156) for intergenerational experiences or for parent programs.

High School Curricula Using NCMEC's "NetSmartz", "NS Teens", and "Power of Parents"

NetSmartz has five (5) Activity Cards at the high school level. They make use of the same vignettes used in earlier lessons with new activities. All vignettes are on the "NetSmartz: Teen Vignettes".

Dependent on the educational backgrounds of Catholic high school students, faculty may choose to use any of the materials suggested for Catholic school students in Grades 5 – 8.

The topic of meeting and/or running away with someone whom students have met online is not covered in Middle School lessons. Specifically, this would include NetSmartz Activity Cards: *Julie's Journey I*; *Amy Choice I*, and *Teens PSA: Promises*.
